### **SUMMARY**

Team members desire to know that their efforts have contributed to the overall success of the team, department, and organization. Effective leaders focus positive attention for good results on their team rather than themselves. Sharing the glory allows team members to see their efforts as more than single activities, but rather as a larger contribution to the whole.

#### CONTEXT

Sharing the glory is not just a nice thing to do for people. Sharing the glory is a powerful motivator that reinforces and rewards the most important outcomes people create for the organization. When you recognize people effectively, you reinforce the actions and behaviors we most want to see people repeated. Sharing the glory is simple, immediate, and powerful reinforcement.

In this module, you will develop ways to share the glory that are equally powerful for both the organization and the employee. You will address some of the important issues necessary for recognition to be viewed as motivating and rewarding by our team members, and important for the success of your organization. You will plan and practice a method of recognizing people and teams in a formal and public setting.
